Obituary

Norman Lanier Frazier was born October 15, 1964 in Melbourne, Florida to the late Norman Leroy Frazier and Gladys Berry Frazier. From a young age he learned responsibility and care. He could be found working hard in the store of his late Uncle “Che Che” or helping his late grandmother and mother. Norman was a 1984 graduate of Palm Bay High School and proud member of the football team.

After graduating from Tampa Technical Institute, he began his career as an engineer with the Harris Corporation. His work brought him joy as he traveled across the world, from the sides of aircraft carriers, to hospitals in Singapore and the freeze of Alaskan winters. For the next 30 years, he became a leader in the medical supply field, as a regional manager for General Electric and Philips Medical. His most rewarding career path was opening his own medical installation companies, Phase Communications and Phase 2 Connect.

In 1992, Norman married his wife Martha and they together moved from Cocoa, Florida to Stuart, Florida. In Stuart, they became members of Mount Calvary Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Charles F. Gadson, who he considered a spiritual father. Norman was a devoted servant at Mount Calvary, where he preached, taught Sunday School, and was a mentor for the youth.

Later Norman relocated to Orlando, Florida and began attending Trinity Church. He was a hardworking Man of God and he invested many hours of quality time at Trinity Church. He played a key role in the church acquiring a new sanctuary at the Haines City campus. Norman was ordained an Associate Pastor under Pastor Charles E. Anderson. He became known to many as “Pastor Norm”.

Norman was preceded in death by his mother and father, sister Minetta Servant, daughter, ShaMia servant, and grandmother, Minnie Sealey. He leaves to cherish his memory, a loving and devoted wife Martha Frazier, a brother, Curtis Frazier, sister, Anna Kennedy, son, Norman Frazier Jr., three daughters, ShaKami Servant, ShaLana Servant, and Alexis Beaufort.
